The work may form part of a PhD, dissertation or sabbatical project: the aim of the Latimer Trust is to facilitate access to this work by publication, whether as a Latimer Study, articles in journals etc.

The area of study should be in the fields of Christian Doctrine and/or Historical Theology with an emphasis on the practical benefits of the research for today's church.
