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The Latimer Trust invites applications for a reading week hosted by a supportive evangelical theological college.

The main purpose of the Latimer Trust is to provide resource material for the church but we also wish to provide opportunities for those in ministry to access new materials and be refreshed. Priority will be given to candidates who are working in ordained Anglican ministry within the British Isles, who should normally have served for at least 3 years, and whose research topic is in the fields of Christian Doctrine and/or Historical Theology with an emphasis on the practical benefits for today's church. The study proposed need not have any published outcomes, although a brief report with critiques and recommendations as a result of the week's reading would be required.
